THE “EFFECTIVE THEATRES” PHILOSOPHY

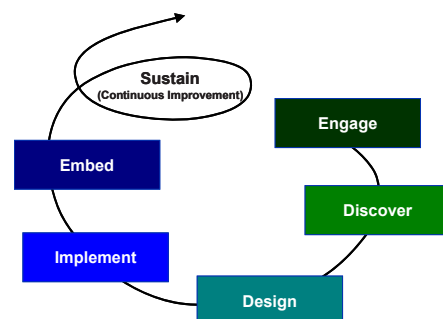
The Effective Theatres programme addresses the core drivers for the engine of the hospital, namely:

THE “EFFECTIVE THEATRES” METHODOLOGY

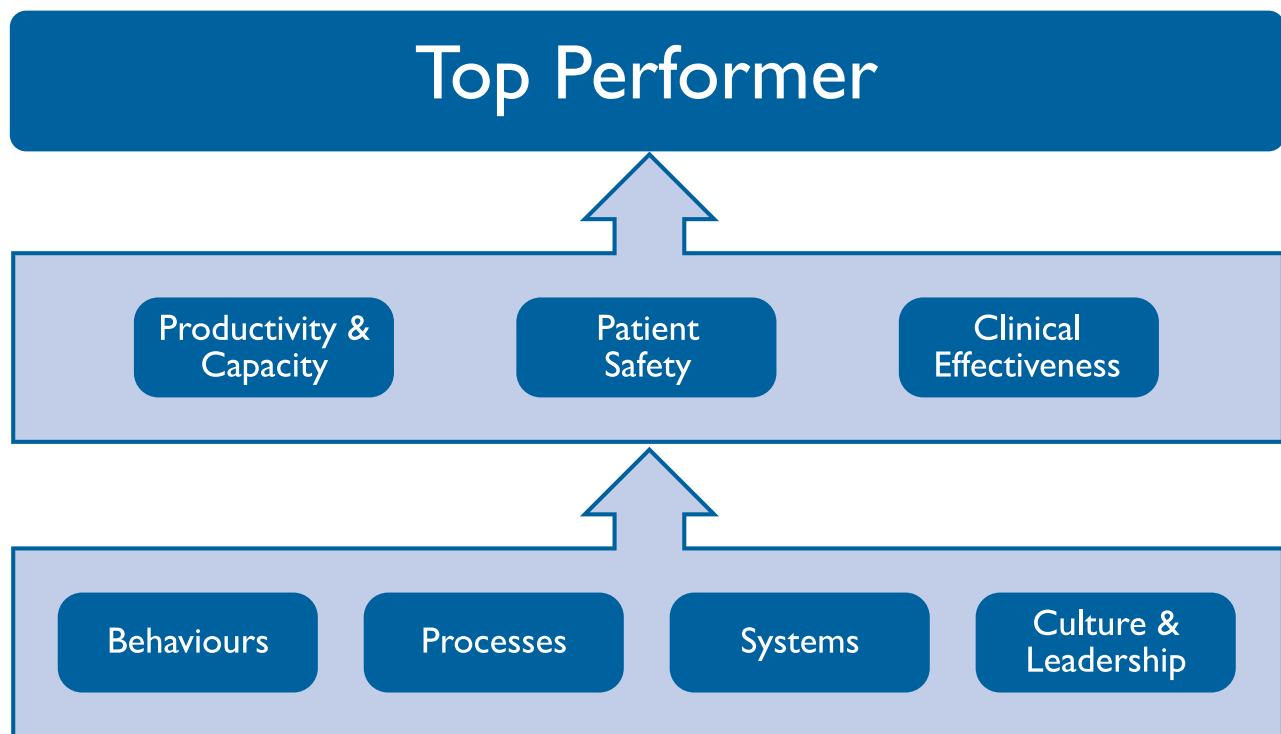
We customise our methodology to reflect each individual organisation based on an understanding of its aspirations, current situation, activities and culture.
